Computer Basics - Thursday, August 3rd at 2:00 PM

This class is an introduction to the various parts of a computer; the importance and difference between hardware and software; using a mouse/keyboard; and an overview of how to launch programs.

Internet Basics - Monday, August 7th at 2:00 PM

What is the internet? Why is it useful? This class will cover accessing websites, different browsers, common buttons and menus, and more! (Computer Basics recommended.)

Android – Wednesday, August 9th at 11:00 AM

A basic introduction to tablets and phones with the Android operating system (NOT iPad/iPhone). Covers touch gestures, settings menus, and how to download apps. Feel free to bring your own device, for the best experience!

iPad/iPhone - Wednesday, August 9th at 2:00 PM

Bring your iPad or iPhone to class and learn the basics or some new tips. Considering purchasing one? Come to class and see if they are right for you! Covers touch gestures, settings menus, and how to download apps.

Prepare for the Eclipse! – Tuesday, August 15th at 2:00 PM

An historic event will be occurring one week after this class: a total solar eclipse. Tourists nationwide are flocking to parks and hotels across the path of totality. Research universities are launching camera-equipped weather balloons to record the event from the upper atmosphere. Learn how to take digital photos using your smartphone or tablet. This class will also cover basic editing tools included on your device. (Android or iPad/iPhone recommended.)

Google Drive - Monday, August 28th at 2:00 PM

*What is cloud storage? Why would you want to use it? This class will introduce you to Google Drive, a free cloud storage service provided by Google. **If you already have a Google account, please bring your account login information.** (Computer and Internet Basics recommended.)*
