# Children's Bookmark Contest


## Every Hero Has a Story! • For ages 3-13

Fill in the bookmark space below with an original design and turn it in to one of the library's Youth Desks by May 31. All entries will be displayed in the library during June and the winning bookmark in each age group will be printed and distributed at the library this summer.

### Contest Rules:

- Each entry must be the original work of one child; one submission per child.
- Designs may be horizontal or vertical. Use the bookmark space provided on this entry form and turn in the whole form intact.
- Any 2D art medium may be used (crayon, markers, colored pencil, etc.). Please no computer generated images or 3D materials (glitter, glued items, etc.).
- Words and numbers may be included in the design, however, **please do not put your name anywhere on the bookmark.** Make sure any writing is legible and neat.
- Do not use copyrighted characters, art, logos, etc.
- The contest runs from May 1 to May 31 and is open to children ages 3-13. All entries are due by May 31. Return your entry to the one of the library's Youth Desks.
- A winner will be selected by library staff in three age groups: 3-5, 6-8 and 9-13. Winners will be notified by phone.
