Feeling adventurous? Can't find anyone to play your favorite board games? During this session, we will explore the many board games that have been reconstituted as mobile apps and can be downloaded for free on your favorite devices. Bring Google or App Store login information.

Create Your Own eNewsletter - Thurs., Oct. 19th at 2:00 PM

This session will explore Canva, a free online design site that allows you to create your own eNewsletter. We will experiment with some of the editing options available. Canva does not provide for distribution. (Computer and Internet Basics recommended.)

Mobile Photos - Tuesday, October 24th at 11:00 AM

Learn how to take digital photos using your smartphone or tablet. This class will also cover basic editing tools included on your device. (Android or iPad/iPhone recommended.)

How Do You YouTube - Thursday, Oct. 26th at 2:00 PM

Do you actively use YouTube? Have you ever wondered how it might be possible to upload your own videos to share with others? This class will cover the basics on creating a video using a mobile device, and uploading it to the popular, online video platform. (Computer and Internet Basics recommended.)
