Program Descriptions*

Teen Take & Make (Ages 13-18)

If you missed doing any of our take & make DIY projects, here's your chance to try out kits from previous weeks! Follow along at home with a how-to tutorial video. No registration is required. **Kits: Pickup in the Lobby (while supplies last).**

Tween DIY (Ages 9-13)

Pick up your FREE kit of supplies then follow along with the instructional video at home. Supplies are given out on a first come basis. **Kits: Pickup weekly Saturday-Friday at Children's Desk (while supplies last).**

KidStir (Ages 5-8)

Murder Mystery Kit: "They All Came Tumbling Down"

About the mystery: 92-year-old Amy Newell is healthy, happy, and full of life — until she's found dead at the bottom of her stairs. Initially thought to be an accident, a keen-eyed mortician identifies a clue that points towards murder. Find out if you can solve the case in our take-home murder mystery kit! Kits contain evidence, puzzles, and suspect dossiers — everything you'll need to solve the mystery on your own or with a group!
