

Chess Mix (All ages)

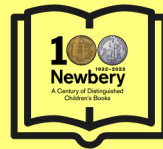
Join us for an afternoon of chess and a savory snack! We'll bring the snacks and the chess sets. This program is for all ages and skill levels!
