Community Show & Tell (All ages)

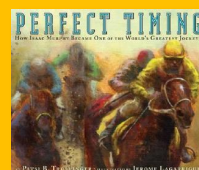
Come show us your treasure and tell us its story! Each person has approximately 5 minutes to be the star. Sign up at the event.
